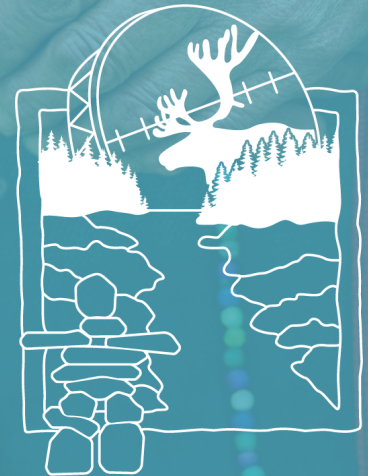

- May include leading sharing circles, offering prayer and spiritual ceremonies according to traditions and culture, hunting, fishing, gathering, storytelling and teachings of respecting the land and all it offers.

- Must live a healthy lifestyle and provide a current criminal record check and vulnerable sector check
